I must be aware of the hazards associated with each activity, such as use of equipment, slips and falls, and various athletic injuries related to the game of football/cheerleading. I agree:

To obey the rules and regulations and to follow the directions of my coaches and attending staff. To inform my coach or a staff member of any dangerous or potentially hazardous situations I may observe. That if I do not understand how an activity is performed or how a piece of equipment to be used, I will ask a coach or staff member prior to beginning the activity. If I receive any equipment or uniform, which will allow me to participate in this program, I understand I am responsible for that piece of equipment or uniform and will return it to the coach, either at the end of the season or when I am no longer a member of the team. If I fail to return my assigned equipment and/or uniform, I am aware that I will be charged the cost of replacing it. To inform a coach or staff member if I have any problems meeting the physical requirements necessary for participation in any activity. Not to be transported to and from games and practices at any time in open pick-up trucks. Further I am aware this is against the law.

In consideration of the right to participate in football/cheerleading and in further consideration of the arrangements made for me by Rockville Football League and the Mayor and Council of Rockville, through its Department of Recreation and Parks for food, travel and recreation, I do hereby, on behalf of myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, assume the above-mentioned risks, and do further release, hold harmless, and indemnify the Mayor and Council of Rockville and all of its agents, officers and employees and all members of the RFL Board of Directors from any and all claims for injuries or loss to any person or property which may arise out of or result from any participation in the above-referenced program or activity. I further grant permission for a doctor to administer emergency treatment to my son/daughter in the event that I cannot be reached in a medical emergency.
